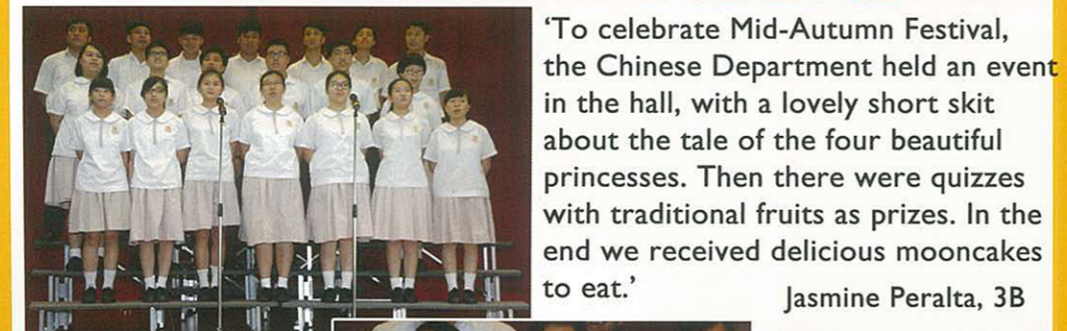

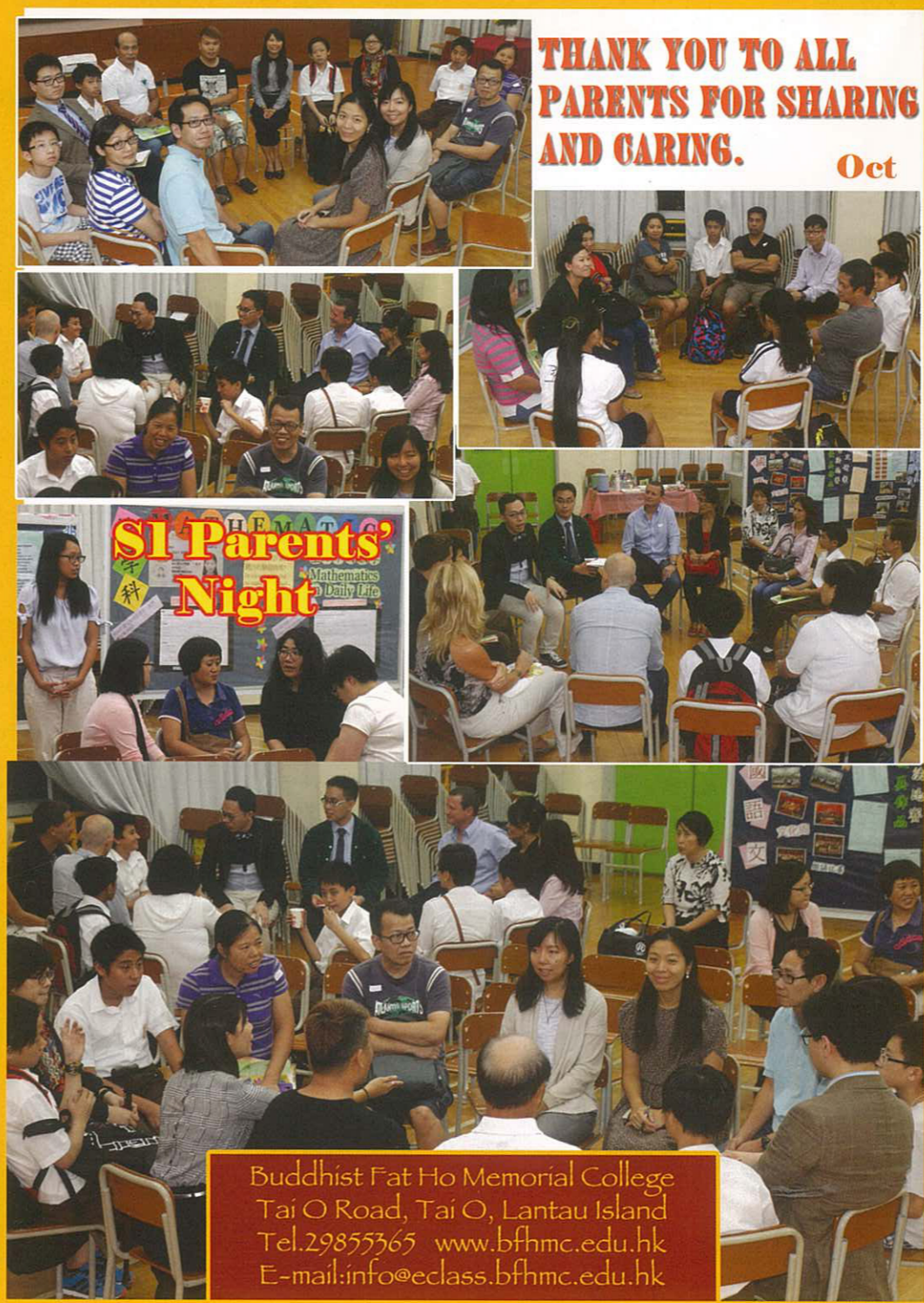

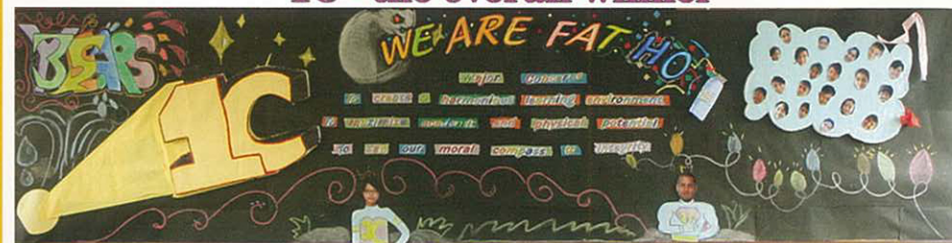
Opening Ceremony
